Registration Fee Information

Enrollment for returning families takes place each year around mid-January. At this time the enrollment fee of \$460.00 will be due for returning students. Once our returning families have completed enrollment, we open remaining available to new families. The fee is \$560 and is due upon completing the enrollment packet.

Parents' Club Fee

The Parents' Club fee is due each year and is used to start the PC funding for the school year. This once a year fee is billed to your FACTS agreement and comes out with the first tuition payment.

Parent Service Hours

This fee is per family, not per student. Each family is required to volunteer 25 hours per school year. We understand that not every family has the time or schedule that allows all hours be volunteered, so donations will also count towards your hours. Every donation in the amount of \$20 counts as an hour. We have a SignUp Genius available with items needed along with an Amazon Wishlist, teachers and Parents' Club also ask for donations throughout the year.

If you select the Payment in Full (1 payment) Agreement, this waives your Service Hour requirements. Families are required to log their hours in the system and quarterly statements are sent with the balances remaining. Volunteer hours and donations need to be fulfilled by the beginning of May each year. All hours remaining will be billed out at \$20 an hour. Final statements are sent at the beginning of May and all fees are due by month end.

Devices

Starting in 1st grade students move to having their own device. Families purchase a device for their student and the fees are part of the tuition agreement. If you selected monthly payments the device would also be paid monthly.

The fees vary from year to year depending on the device chosen. We use Chromebooks for testing and security purposes. If you already have a device (not an ipad) that is also acceptable and there is no need to purchase a new device. If it is a Chromebook, we are required to manage the device and a license only would need to be purchased. Managing the device allows us to process student testing on the device and push out our security measures.

Some of the security we enable is a firewall (school only) that has search restrictions enabled. On the actual devices we enable safe search and disable the ability to remove search history.

Miscellaneous Fees:

Most classrooms will have a small classroom fee that will be invoiced the first week of school. The fees are for craft supplies, subscriptions, etc. The Middle School Classroom fees are for their Science Labs and Bible. The exception to this is 8th grade. The fees for 8th grade are billed at the end of the year and are for graduation expenses, trip, and dance.

Please note – all invoices for miscellaneous items such as class fees, before / after school program, milk, etc. have a due date. There is a 10 day grace period, however, if payment is not made within that time frame there are late fees assessed. The late fee is \$20.00 initially and continues each month until payment is received. Past due accounts will result in the holding of records and report cards.
